(3) Accordingly, the Criminal Application (APPA) No. 330/2023 along with Criminal Appeal (St) No. 1503/2023 is hereby **dismissed**. The Proceedings in Criminal Application (APPA) No. 290/2024 along with Criminal Appeal (St) No. 2246/2024 is continued.

(4) The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Nagpur to quantify the honorarium of Shri G.L. Agrawal, learned Counsel, if any, as per the Rules.

CRIMINAL APPLICATION (APPA) NO. 290/2024

(5) Heard Shri A.S. Londhe, learned Counsel for the Appellant and Shri N. Joshi, learned APP for the Respondent/State.

(6) It appears that there is delay of 838 days in filing the Criminal Appeal (St) No. 2246/2024. The Accused is in jail.
