1. The applications are for grant of pre-arrest bail in connection with Crime No.345/2024, registered under Section 379, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 48 (8) of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code and Sections 3(1), 181, 130, 177 of the Motor Vehicles Act.

Both the vehicles are found at the excavation site. As per the allegation, they have excavated the sand without having the permit illegally and caused damage to the Government revenue.
