This is an application seeking to quash First Information Report ("FIR") vide Crime No. 382/2024 registered with Police Station Ambazari, Nagpur for the offence punishable under Sections 279, 338 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 134, 177 of the Motor Vehicles Act. It is applicant's submission that the informant's husband was himself in fault which is evident in CCTV footage.

3. The applicant seeks for early hearing as he has to apply for VISA.
