Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of certiorari, calling for the records relating to the order dt. 2-3-2006 in OASR No.295 of 2006 from the file of the Central Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad Bench and after perusing the same quash the said order dt.2-3-2006 and also set aside the letter No.G/P.648/111/3/Mech.Clerk dt.14-12-2005 issued by the 3rd respondent, by declaring them as arbitrary, discriminatory and illegal and/or alternatively declare the order dt.1-3-2004 in OA No.99 of 2003 in so far as it relates to non consideration of grievance of the petitioner to re-fix his pension, gratuity amount, as illegal and invalid and consequently direct the respondents to re-fix the petitioner's pension;

gratuity amount taking into consideration of the last pay drawn by him prior to his retirement and also award interest on the said pensionary benefits and with all other consequential benefits, monetary and otherwise.
