This Petition has been filed under Section 372 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925 seeking Succession Certificate to the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner with power to collect the shares and to receive interest or profits accrued therein and negotiate and transfer the securities specified in the schedule.

2.After following due procedure, the Petitioners were invited to tender evidence. the Petitioners were examined as PW1 & PW2 and Ex.P1 to Ex.P.11 were marked, which are as follows:
