### **ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to direct the first respondent not to harass the petitioner except under due process of law.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the first respondent.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the first respondent submits that on the complaint given by the defacto complainant against the petitioner, petition enquiry is pending in C.S.R. No.378 of 2023 on the file of the first respondent.

4. The petitioner is directed to co-operate with the police for enquiry and at the time of conducting of the enquiry, the petitioner shall not be harassed by the police. The police cannot call the petitioner on a regular basis in the guise of enquiry without even registering an FIR and the Supreme Court of India in the case of ***Lalitha Kumari Vs. Government of Uttar Pradesh*** [reported in ***2013 (6) CTC 353***] has enumerated the nature of cases where the preliminary enquiry can be conducted and has also restricted the period, for which, the preliminary enquiry can be conducted. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the first respondent is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be a shield for the petitioner against the first respondent proceeding to take action in accordance with law.
