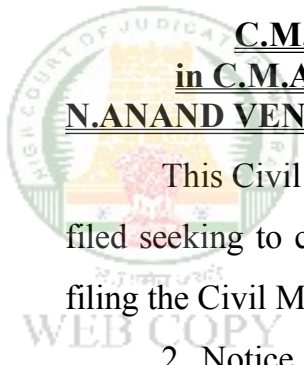

This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 95 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
