Prayer in WP.No.798 of 2021: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned order passed by the first respondent herein in his proceedings Rc.No. 298305/Rect.2(1)/2019 dated 28/10/2020 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents herein to add the 231 marks along with 607.67 marks obtained by him during the final exams conducted at Tamilnadu Police Academy in the year 2011- 12 and re-fix the seniority of the petitioner taking into account the total marks obtained by him i.e. 838.7, together with all consequential service and monetary benefits, within a time frame.

Prayer in WP.No.18433 of 2021:Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent herein to include the petitioner's name in C' List of Sub-Inspectors of Police (Armed Reserve) fit for promotion as Inspector of Police (Armed Reserve) for the year 2020 issued in proceedings of the first respondent herein in his proceedings Rc.No. NGB-1(1)/E/0021/2020, NGB Order No.17/2021 dated 9/08/2021 at the



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appropriate place taking into account the total marks 795-67 obtained by him during the final exams conducted at Tamilnadu Police College, Ashok Nagar, Chennai 600083, together with all consequential service and monetary benefits, within a time frame.
