Civil Suit filed under Order IV Rule 1 of Original Side Rules 1956 read with Order VII Rule 1 CPC praying for the following judgment and decree against the defendants.

A] To divide the immovable properties described in the Schedule – A into eight equal shares by metes and bounds with reference to good and bad soil and allot one such share to second and third plaintiff.

b] To divide the immovable properties described in the schedule - B into three equal shares by metes and bounds with reference to good and bad soil and allot one such share to Mrs.S.Vatchaladevi, late Mrs.P.Parijatham and Late Mrs.S.Philomanal respectively.



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c] To divide the 1/3rd share of late Mrs.P.Parijatham in the schedule –

B properties and allot 1/24th share to the defendants 1 – 8 being the lineal descendants of late Mrs.P.Parijatham.

d] To divide the 1/3rd share of the later Mrs.S.Philomanal in the schedule – B properties and allot 1/9th share to 9th defendant being the husband and allot 2/45th share to the defendants 10-14th being the lineal descendants of late Mrs.S.Philomanal.

e) directing the defendants to pay costs of the suit
