ORDER

The petitioner seeks bail in Crime No.2073 of 2023, registered by the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 273 of IPC and Section 24(1) of COTPA Act and Section 77 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. The petitioner had been remanded to judicial custody on 30.12.2023.

2.It is stated that from A1 55 kgs of banned tobacco products had been seized. The learned Principal Sessions Judge,Tiruppur had granted bail to A1 on 05.01.2024 in Crl.MP.No.34 of 2024.

3. Taking all the facts into consideration, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

4.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Court-I, Tiruppur and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix his photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of his Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure his identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) to the credit of Tamil Nadu Advocate's Clerk's Association, High Court Buildings, High Court, Chennai, Account Name: Tamil Nadu Advocate's Clerk's Association, A/c No.484026006, Indian Bank, High Court Branch, IFSC Code:IDIB000M157.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
