ORDER

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the status report

of the respondent was filed and the relevant portions are extracted hereunder:

“9. I respectfully submit that in compliance with the order passed by this Hon'ble Court. I took up the case for further investigation and gave a requisition letter to Thasildhar, Panruti and received the documents which were filed by the then Inspector of Police already.

10. I respectfully submit that after obtained the documents, I have conducted further investigation in this case and examined the following witnesses and recorded their further statements.
