ORDER



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The petitioner/A3 in Crime No.153 of 2023, registered by the respondent for the offences under Sections 341, 302, 506(2) of IPC, seeks bail. Originally, the petitioner had been granted bail but later he had absconded from judicial process on 05.08.2023. The petitioner was remanded to custody on 05.12.2023.

2.The one factor this Court had noticed that A2 was also absconding but it is informed that A2 had surrendered before the Judicial Magistrate I, Krishnagiri on 30.01.2024.

3.In view of that particular fact and taking into consideration the period of incarceration, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions:

4.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate I, Krishnagiri, and on further conditions that: -

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall appear before the Judicial Magistrate



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II, Krishnagiri, everyday 10.30 a.m., until further orders, apart from the Court hearing dates.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
