Prayer: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Declaration declaring Section 4(3) of the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, amendment Act 13 of 2003 as ultra vires, unconstitutional and void by substituting clause 8(1) of the I Schedule, enhancing the tax for the petitioner's educational institution vehicles from Rs.500/- per quarter to Rs.150/- per seat per quarter.
