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11.06.2004 published in notification dated 14.06.2004 published in Tamil Nadu Government Gazettee part II, Section 2 cancelling the notification of the 2nd respondent Town Panchayat in order to become Village Panchayat, modifying the status of the second respondent/Town Panchayat to the status of the Village Panchayat, in contradiction with the provisions of Article 243 U of the Constitution of India and the corresponding provisions of the Tamil Nadu District Municipalities Act, violating the procedures prescribed under Section 3-B of the Tamil Nadu Act V of 920 as illegal, unconstitutional, void and unenforceable.
