ORDER

The Writ Petition is filed for the writ of Mandamus directing the first and second respondent to conclude the conciliation proceedings in the industrial dispute raised by the petitioner dated 01.08.2023 within such time as stipulated by this Hon'ble Court, with a further direction to the first respondent to pass orders in the industrial dispute.

2. The industrial dispute was raised by the petitioner Union on 01.08.2023 before the Conciliation Officer with regard to the issue of production increase made by the third respondent Management.

3. Considering the limited prayer of the petitioner, direction is issued to



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the second respondent to conclude the conciliation proceeding and communicate the report to the first respondent within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The first respondent shall within four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of the report of the second respondent shall pass orders regarding reference under Section 10 of the Act. The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed off. Consequently connected miscellaneous petition is also closed. No Costs.
