COMMON ORDER

The petitioner/A1 has filed Crl.O.P.No.2018 of 2024 and the petitioners/A2 and A3 have filed Crl.O.P.No.2019, both in Crime No.17 of 2024, registered by the respondent for the offence under Section 379 of IPC. They were remanded to custody on 08.01.2024.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that all the three accused, travel in a crowded bus and commit theft of jewels. It is stated that similarly they had snatched the chain from the defacto complainant.

3.The learned counsels for the petitioners claimed that these petitioners are innocent of the offences.

4.It is stated on behalf of the respondent that investigation has

been completed and final report has also been filed.

5.Taking all those factors into consideration, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioners in both the criminal original petitions subject to the following conditions:

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Tiruppur, and on further conditions that: -

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
