**ORDER**

This Civil Revision Petition has been filed to direct the learned Subordinate Judge, Palacode to dispose of the case in O.S.No.123/2019, within a time frame, as fixed by this court.

2. The petitioner herein is the third defendant and the first respondent herein is the plaintiff in the above said suit, which was filed for partition of the suit property. The status of the case shows that, though it was posted for

trial, in view of the pendency of interlocutory application, trial not yet commenced. According to the petitioner, the plaintiff is dragging the matter, by way of filing application and hence this petition has been filed.

3. At this juncture, it is worthwhile to note that the ***Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.No.587/2023, dated 10.11.2023, in Shaikh Uzma Feroz Hussain Vs. The State of Maharashtra*** has dismissed the writ petition, by observing as follows.

“ We are of the view that since every High Court and every Court in the country has a huge pendency, the Constitutional Court should avoid temptation of fixing a time-bound schedule for disposal of any case, before any court, unless the situation is extra ordinary.”

4. Further, pursuant to the direction of this Court, the Registry, on verification through e-filing, has reported that the total pendency of the cases in the above Court is 720.

5. Considering the pendency of the cases and also taking note of the fact that the above case is pending from the year 2019, the learned Subordinate Judge, Palacode is directed to dispose of the suit in O.S.No.123/2019, ***within eight months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.***
