ORDER

3. A perusal of the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 04.01.2021 reveals that there is a dispute between the



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petitioner and the respondents 4 & 5 herein in respect of the property comprised in No.9, Dunning Kuppam (Iruthayapuram), Chennai. Therefore, the dispute between the private parties cannot be considered by the respondents 1 to 3. That apart, the complaint lodged by the petitioner before the third respondent was enquired and closed. Hence, this writ petition is devoid of merits and is liable to be dismissed.
