ORDER

The petitioner/A2 was arrested and remanded to judicial custody
for the offences registered under Sections 392 of I.P.C, in Crime No.107 of
2022 on the file of the respondent Police, seek bail.



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2. It is stated that investigation was completed and charge sheet has been filed in C.C.No.16181 of 2022 and the same is pending. It is stated that NBW has been issued against the petitioner on 21.08.2023 and the petitioner had been secured on 12.10.2023. A2 was also arrested in some other case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has filed a memo and the same may be taken on record

4. Taking all the factors into consideration and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with two fresh sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned V Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai -8** and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix his photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of his Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure his identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the **V Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai -8** on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., till completion of trial, apart from the Court hearing dates.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
