WEB COPY When the matter came up for hearing today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner fairly submitted that the writ petition involving an identical issue was disposed of by this Court on 03.06.2024 in W.P. Further, he seeks liberty to resolve the dispute between the parties in relation to the Agreement, dated 19.10.2017 before the learned Sole Arbitrator.
