ORDER

The petitioner/A1 who was arrested and remanded to judicial
custody on 27.12.2023 for the offences registered under Sections 8(c), 22(b)
and 29(1) of NDPS Act, in Crime No.571 of 2023, on the file of the



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respondent Police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused were found in possession of 45 numbers of Nitravet-10 tablets weighing about 25.650 grams.

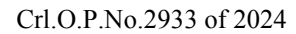
3.It is stated by the learned Government Advocate (crl.side) that A2 and A3 are still absconding and they are went out for the contraband. The petitioner has no previous against him.

4.Taking into consideration the period of incarceration and also considering the quantity of contraband seized, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

5.Accordingly, the petitioner are ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned XV Metropolitan Magistrate, George Town, Chennai and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.



[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
