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ORDER

The petitioners/A1 and A2 in Crime No.591 of 2023, registered by the respondent for the offences under Sections 341, 147, 148, 294(b), 324, 506(2) and 307 of IPC and they had been remanded to judicial custody on 17.11.2023 with respect to an occurrence which took place on 14.11.2023, seek bail.

2.It is stated that A1 and another Venkatesan had threatened the defacto complainant Manoharan not to speak to the other Venkatesan but however, the defacto complainant and Venkatesan were talking and this was found out by the accused who attacked both of them. They had been admitted to hospital and had been discharged after three days. It is stated that there are two juveniles involved in the offence.

3.Taking into consideration the period of incarceration and the fact that the injured had been discharged from the hospital, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioners herein subject to the following conditions:

4.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate – II, Tiruvallur, and on further



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conditions that: -

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
