**PRAYER:** Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. praying to enlarge the petitioners on bail concerned in Crime No.1111 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police on such terms and conditions.

**ORDER**

The petitioners/A1 and A2 in Crime No.1111 of 2023, registered by the respondent for the offences under Sections 447, 294(b), 332, 342,



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353, 506(i) and 307 of IPC, seek bail. They had been remanded to judicial custody on 21.11.2023.

2.It is stated that the petitioners visited the RTO Office at Tiruppur and enquired about the status of the mini bus route permit with the RTO/the defacto complainant. There was a quarrel which escalated into violence. It is stated that A3 had been granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

3.The main objection raised on behalf of the respondent is about the previous cases against A1 but it is seen that one case is of the year 2023 and other three are in the years 2010 and 2012. There is also one previous case against A2.

4.Taking all the factors into consideration and the fact that the respondent had recorded statements from eight witnesses including five eye witnesses, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioners subject to the following conditions:

5.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the



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satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate III, Tiruppur, and on further conditions that: -

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

**[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.**

[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
