This Writ petition is filed as against the Air India Limited directing the 2nd respondent to facilitate and co-operate to conduct elections of the Southern, Eastern and Hyderabad regions and now the entire 100% of shares of AIR India Ltd., were transferred in the name of M/s.Talace Pvt. Ltd., hence the main petition itself becomes infructuous. Recording the above said submission, this Writ petition is dismissed as 'infructuous'. No costs. The connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
