The petitioner has filed an application under the provisions of Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 [for brevity, "the SARFAESI Act, 2002"] on 18.05.2023. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the same is not yet decided.

3. We are not aware of the number of matters pending with the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate.

4. The application is filed after the sale of the property. The petitioner shall make an application with the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate for expeditious disposal of the application filed under the provisions of Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act, 2002, which



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application shall be considered by the Chief Judicial Magistrate and may endeavour to decide the application filed under the provisions of Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act, 2002 expeditiously.

5. The writ petition, accordingly, stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
