Notice to respondents 1 and 2 is dispensed with since they remained *ex parte* before the Tribunal. Notice to the fourth respondent is also dispensed with since the Tribunal has not awarded any compensation for the fourth respondent, who is the father of the deceased.

2. Mr.Suresh Srinivasan, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of third respondent insurance company.

3. This Civil Miscellaneous petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 49 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the records.



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5. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 49 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.
