ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the first respondent to remove the petitioner's name from the Rowdy History Sheet bearing No.05/Inspr/V7/HS/17.

2. The case of the petitioner is that three cases have been registered against the petitioner, out of which, two cases were disposed of by the competent Court. Except these cases, no other case is pending against the petitioner. However, the respondents have included the name of the petitioner in History Sheet bearing No.05/Inspr/V7/HS/17. The petitioner submitted a representation dated 09.08.2023 to the first respondent to remove his name from the history sheet. Since no action was taken on the representation of the petitioner, the present writ petition has been filed seeking for the aforesaid relief.

3. Heard Mr.S.Arunkumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.A.Damodaran, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of respondents.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a direction to the respondents to act on the representation made by the petitioner and deal with the same in accordance with the guidelines issued by

Nagar, (L&O) Range, Madurai city, Madurai and others [2018 4 MLJ CrL.

585] and *Thirumurugan and another Vs. The Superintendent of Police,*

Madurai [2020 2 LW crl 266] and pass appropriate orders, within a period of

four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner is

directed to make a fresh representation to the respondents along with a copy of

this order.

This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
