This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant Mr.M.Sivakumar and Ms.C.Bhuvanasundari, learned counsel for the 2nd respondent are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties and their respective counsel are present.

2. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.8,50,000/(Rupees Eight Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) with interest at 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit as compensation.

3. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties have agreed to enhance the award amount as Rs.8,50,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakh Fifty Thousand only) in full quit (inclusive of interest and costs) over and above the award passed by the tribunal as compensation and the same is awarded accordingly.

4. The 1st appellant/Wife is permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.4,50,000/- and the 2nd and 3rd appellants/Daughters are permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.2,00,000/- each in the award amount.

5. The 2nd respondent/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the award amount, now ordered after deducting any amount already deposited, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a



copy of this order. Award is passed accordingly.

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6. The Tribunal is directed to issue the award amount through NEFT/RTGS to the party concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

7. The appeal is ordered accordingly. Consequently, the connected MP, if any, is closed.
