Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ or order or direction in the nature of Writ directing the respondents herein to make payments of compensation and solatium to the tune of Rs.23.00 lakhs to the Petitioners for the untimely and sudden death caused to Vellaisamy, Son of Pandian, aged 48 years due to electrocution happened on 08.10.2010 forthwith and to pass such further or other orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and thus render justice.

JUDGMENT

[Judgment of this Court was delivered by T.RAJA, J.]

This writ appeal has been filed challenging the order dated 18.01.2018 passed in W.P. No.16984 of 2011 in and by which the learned Single Judge, while coming to the conclusion that a compensation of Rs.7.50 lakhs would not only be just and reasonable, but would also meet the ends of justice, directed the appellant/third respondent to pay a sum of Rs.7.50 lakhs as compensation to the claimants/respondents 1 to 4. Aggrieved by the same, the appellant is before this Court.

When the matter was taken up for hearing on 07.06.2022, there was no representation for the appellant and therefore, the registry was directed to be listed the matter today under the caption for dismissal. Even today there is no representation for the appellant, which shows that the appellant is not interested in prosecuting the appeal. Therefore, this writ appeal is liable to be dismissed for default. Accordingly, this writ appeal stands dismissed for default. No costs.
