We have heard Mr.R.Prabakar, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.K.Karthik Jagannath, learned Government Advocate for the respondents 1 to 3, 5 and 6, Mr.Abhishek Murthy and Ms.P.Shanthi, learned counsel for the fourth respondent. None appears for the respondents 7 and 8.

2. It is alleged that the building was constructed on the Natham land by the villagers. The villagers contributed for the construction and the respondents 7 and 8, without any authority, are occupying it.
