If such application is filed by the petitioner, the Committee may consider the said application on its own merits and in accordance with law, after observing the principles of natural justice, and take necessary action within a period of eight months from the date of receipt of the application.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. There shall be no order as to costs.
