ORDER

Mr.K.Tippu Sultan, learned Government Advocate accepts notice for the respondents and is armed with instructions to enable final disposal of this Writ Petition, even at the stage of admission.

2. The prayer of the petitioner is to release her from compulsory bond, as according to the petitioner, the services rendered by her during covid period would more than suffice to enable the prayer sought.

3. The petitioner has produced a covid duty certificate, the details of which are factual in nature, to be ascertained by the authorities. Since the petitioner has made the same request as in this Writ Petition by way of representation dated 05.03.2024, received by the respondents on 09.03.2024, Mr.Tippu Sultan, would agree that the Director of Medical



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Education/R2 will consider the representation and pass orders expeditiously.

4. Hence, mandamus is issued to R2 to consider the representation of the petitioner in light of the prevailing Government Orders as applicable to the candidate. For this purpose, the petitioner shall appear before R2 on any working day between 25.03.2024 and 12.04.2024 between working hours without awaiting any further notice in this regard.

5. R2 shall give audience to the petitioner, hear her and pass orders on her representation in accordance with law and all prevailing Government Orders, within a period of three (3) weeks from date of her personal hearing.

6. This Writ Petition is disposed as above. No costs.
