COMMON ORDER

The writ petitions have been filed seeking to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned order dated 10.01.2005 and the No relief award dated 18.01.2005 passed in Industrial dispute Nos.321 & 366 / 2001, to quash the same and consequently to direct the 1st respondent to restore the industrial disputes Nos.321 & 366 / 2001 for trial.
