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An affidavit of service has been filed in SR No.15870 of 2021 dated 25.04.2024. Service is complete.

2. This Civil Miscellaneous petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 228 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the Appellant and perused the records.

4. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 228 days is condoned.

5. Registry is directed to number the main Civil miscellaneous appeal and list the same for admission. The Registry is further directed to verify the affidavit of service and if any counsel has entered appearance for R2, the name of learned counsel for 2nd respondent shall be printed in the cause-list or else the name of 2nd respondent shall be printed in the cause-list, at the time of posting the case for admission.

6. It is made clear that for the period of delay of 228 days, the appellant will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
