### **ORDER**

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking police protection based on the representation given by the petitioner on 7.3.2024.

2.Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), on instructions, submitted that, based on the representation given by the petitioner, petition enquiry is pending in CSR No.100/2024, on the file of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent Police.

3.The 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent while dealing with the representation, shall take into consideration the decree that was passed in O.S.No.561 of 1977, AS.No.78 of 2006 and also the order that has been passed by the Execution Court in E.A.No.450 of 2013 in E.P.No.90 of 2013, wherein police protection was ordered.



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4. The petitioner is directed to co-operate with the Police for enquiry and the respondent Police shall conduct the enquiry keeping in mind the judgment in ***Lalitha Kumari vs. Government of Uttar Pradesh*** reported in **2013 (6) CTC 353**. On completion of the enquiry, the respondent Police shall take a decision regarding the further course of action. This process shall be completed by the respondent Police within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is closed. No costs.
