COMMON ORDER

Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that the Crime No.643 of 2020 on the file of the respondent Police was transferred to Central Crime Branch, Chennai and was assigned with Crime No.139 of 2024 and was taken up for investigation and it was found that no cognizable offence is made out. Hence, R.C.S report was filed on 30.07.2024 before Principal Sessions Court, Chennai.
