In the course of further investigation, the statement of the petitioner will also be recorded u/s.161 Cr.P.C. since the petitioner also claims to be a victim.

4. In the light of the above stand, the grievance of the petitioner will be sufficiently taken care.

5. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
