ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the First Information Report in Crime No.1148 of 2021 pending on the file of first respondent.

2. The case is still at the stage of investigation. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3. A Joint Compromise Memo signed by both parties and affidavits of petitioners and second respondent have been filed before this Court. The petitioners and second respondent were present before this Court. In the Joint Memo of Compromise and in the affidavits, it has been stated that the petitioners and the second respondent have entered into a compromise and amicably settled their issues in Crime No.1148 of 2021 pending on the file of first respondent. This Court also enquired both the parties and this Court was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the case pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath)** and after exercising due caution as advised by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **The State of Madhya Pradesh v. Dhruv Gurjar and Another** reported in **(2019) 2 MLJ Crl 10**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the First Information Report in Crime No.1148 of 2021 pending on the file of first respondent.
