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ORDER

We have heard Mr.M.Aloysius Raja Pragash, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.T.K.Saravanan, learned Government Advocate for the respondents.

2. The learned Government Advocate submits that the subject land was surveyed by the Firka Surveyor and a report was submitted. The writ petitioner has been called for an enquiry on 22.02.2024 to appear with original documents available with her and also to conduct enquiry on her representation.

3. The petitioner may appear on 22.02.2024 before the authority concerned. The authority may consider the documents and the representation filed by the petitioner and then take appropriate

decision. Depending upon the decision taken by the authority, the parties are at liberty to take further steps.
