G.O.Ms.No.236 Finance (Pay Cell) Department dated 12.07.2018 and to quash the same in so far as it confines the eligibility scales of pay at Rs.12,000/- is concerned and direct the respondents to revise the pension only with reference to the requisite numbers of years of service i.e 20 years and above, based on the time bound promotion granted by the government in GO.Ms.No 354 Health and Family Welfare Department dated 23.10.2009 and also G.O. Ms. No 106 Higher Education Department dated 14.5.15 and consequently direct the respondents to disburse the difference of pension within a limited frame.
