The petitioner herein is the husband of the detenue viz., Elavarasan, S/o.Karunanidhi, now confined at Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent, dated 05.03.2024 slapped on her husband, branding him as "Immoral Traffic Offender" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Cyber Law Offenders, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Sexual Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 1982].



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2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the petitioner's husband, dated 05.03.2024 has been revoked by the Government in G.O.Rt.No.2265, Home, Prohibition and Excise (XIII) Department, dated 15.04.2024 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.
