The petitioner herein seeks expeditious disposal of the criminal appeal pending on the file of the Principal District Sessions Court, Chengalpet against the judgment dated 12.07.2023 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate -II, Alandur in C.C.No.469 of 2017. Crl.A.Nos.78, 77 and 76 of 2023 respectively filed by the defacto complainant for enhancement of sentence and against acquittal of one of the accused. Being aggrieved, the police are not taken up for final hearing. These three Criminal Original Petitions filed seeking direction to expedite the hearing.
