In view of the said undertaking that all the encroachments will be removed, no further consideration is required. The respondents are directed to remove all the encroachments, as per their own



undertaking within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The 5th respondent is at liberty to submit his objections along with the documents, if any, to the authorities of the Vellore City Municipal Corporation within a period of 10 days from today. In the event of submitting any such objection, the same also is to be looked into by the authorities.

2. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands dismissed. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
