The petitioner herein is the husband of the detenue viz., Muneeshwari, W/o.Jayaveerapandiyan, now confined at Special Prison for Women, Thiruchirappalli, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent, dated 04.04.2024 slapped on his wife, branding her as "Bootlegger" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Cyber Law Offenders, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders,
