3. This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 276 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

5. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, this miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 276 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.

It is made clear that for the period of delay of 276 days, the appellants will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
