The petitioners herein seek anticipatory bail in Crime No.248 of 2024 registered by the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 341, 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners stated that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in Crime No.248 of 2024 registered by the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 341, 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC. Thus, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) stated that, on 26.04.2024, the petitioners abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and also attacked him with hands, due to which, the defacto complainant sustained injuries. Thus, he prays for dismissal of this petition.

4. Taking all the factors into consideration, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.



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conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**;
