The petitioner herein is the wife of the detenu viz., Ravi @ Pasumathur Ravi, aged 55 years, S/o.Veera Manthiri, confined at Central Prison, Vellore, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 12.04.2024 slapped on her husband, branding him as "Bootlegger" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 1982].
