COMMON ORDER

The writ of mandamus has been filed by both the writ petitioners to direct the respondents herein to extend the time and allow the petitioner to execute the agreement and place the trucks for operation as per Letter of Acceptance (LOA) issued in SRCC/ PT/ 111/ TNSO/ 2020-21 dated 09.04.2021 by accepting the security declaration instead of security deposit with replacement of vehicle and consequently refrain from cancelling the Letter of Acceptance (LOA) or blacklisting the Trucks bearing Registration No's KA51 AF 7993 and KA51 AF 7994 (in W.P.No.15902 of 2021) and Registration No's KA51 AF 8000 and TN30 BH 8115 (in W.P.No.15904 of 2021).

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners in both the writ petitions would submit that the tender period expired. Thus, the cause does not exist. The learned counsel for the respondents would submit that no order pertaining to blacklisting the petitioners has been submitted.

3. In view of the fact that the cause became vanished, no further



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adjudication is required and accordingly, the writ petitions stand closed. If any grievance exist to the petitioners, then the petitioners are at liberty to approach the competent authority. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
