Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.5,11,056/- towards earned leave salary with 12% interest per annum, to pay the petitioner interest for Rs.10,00,000/- which was paid to him towards Gratuity belatedly on 14.10.2019, after a delay of 3 years 1 months, and to grant him Special Grade pay from the date of completion of 30 years and to pay him the difference in salary and the difference in Gratuity and



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earned leave salary based on such Special Grade pay with interest, award costs.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for direction directing the respondents pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.5,11,056/- towards earned leave salary with 12% interest per annum, to pay the petitioner interest for Rs.10,00,000/- which was paid to him towards Gratuity belatedly on 14.10.2019, after a delay of 3 years 1 months, and to grant him Special Grade pay from the date of completion of 30 years and to pay him the difference in salary and the difference in Gratuity and earned leave salary based on such Special Grade pay with interest, award costs.

2. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

3. In identical issues, this Court has passed various orders, justifying the payment of interest to the aggrieved pensioners and in the order dated 13.12.2019 in W.P.(MD) No.26481 of 2019, the following order came to be passed :-



6. In the light of the above observations, there shall be a direction to the respondent / Corporation to pay the penal interest at the rate of 6% per annum on the belated payment of the retirement benefits for the period from the date of the retirement, till the date of the actual disbursement, as expeditiously as possible and in any event, not before the expiry of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.”

5. In the light of the above findings, there shall be a direction to the respondents herein to pay the interest on the belated payment of the terminal benefits to the petitioner at the rate of 6% per annum, commencing from the date of the retirement, till the date of actual disbursement, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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6. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
