Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the difference in Provident fund arrears, the difference in leave salary, the difference in Gratuity, the difference in commutation arrears, and Pension arrears with interest at the rate of interest of 8% per annum as per 13th wage settlement, dated 04.01.2018 to the petitioner within a specified time.

ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed seeking for a direction to the respondents to pay the difference in Provident Fund arrears, the difference in leave salary, the difference in gratuity, the difference in commutation arrears and pension arrears with interest at the rate of 8% per annum as per 13th wage settlement, dated 04.01.2018, to the petitioner.

2. *Mr.R.Venkatesa Perumal*, learned Counsel takes notice for the first respondent and *Mr.C.S.K.Sathish*, learned Counsel takes notice for the second respondent. They would submit that the eligible amount will be paid to the petitioner within a reasonable time as may be fixed by this Court.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that, in all the connected matters, this Court has consistently allowed the payment with interest at the rate of 6% per annum.

4. In that view of the matter, this Writ Petition is disposed of on the following terms:



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(i) The respondents shall disburse the difference in Provident Fund arrears, the difference in leave salary, the difference in gratuity, the difference in commutation arrears and pension arrears, as per the 13th wage settlement, dated 04.01.2018, to the petitioner, if he is eligible as per the Rules within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the dates on which the amounts became due, till the date of disbursement.

(ii) If the amounts are not paid within a period of eight (8) weeks, thereafter, the same shall carry the interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the dates on which the amounts became due, till the date of disbursement.

(iii) There shall be no order as to costs.
